In the past week we have had a few developments related to the Covid-19 virus here at Villa Guadalupe, and I am eager to communicate these details to you today.

The results of surveillance testing on all Residents, staff and Little Sisters April 20-21 indicated that everyone was negative, but later in the week several people began to show symptoms of Covid-19 and were tested.

We now have 1 Resident presumed to be positive for Covid-19; this individual has been isolated as we await test results. Two staff members are also now presumed positive; they have both been off work as we wait for test results.

As a cautionary measure all Residents are now eating in their rooms.

We continue to follow all CDC guidelines and directives of the New Mexico Department of Health already put in place to assure the safety and wellbeing of Residents and staff alike.

We hope that you have been able to communicate as often as you wish with your loved one in the Home. If not, please let us know and we will facilitate contact. The residents continue to amaze us at how well they are coping with our current situation.

Please know that we remain committed to providing your loved one with the best care possible at all times, especially during these difficult weeks. Please join us in praying for an end to the pandemic!
